

LOCAL GOVERNMENT AND PUBLIC INVOLVEMENT IN HEALTH ACT 2007

The District of New Forest (Reorganisation of Community Governance) (Ellingham, Harbridge & Ibsley Parish Council) Order 2015

Made: 3 March 2015

Coming into force in accordance with Article 1(2)

New Forest District Council ("the council"), in accordance with section 82 of the Local Government and Public Involvement in Health Act 2007 ("the 2007 Act") has undertaken a community governance review and made recommendations dated 25 February 2015.

The council has decided to give effect to those recommendations and, in accordance with section 93 of the 2007 Act, has consulted with the local government electors and other interested persons and has had regard to the need to secure that community governance reflects the identities and interests of the community and is effective and convenient:

The council, in accordance with section 100 of the 2007 Act, has had regard to guidance issued under that section:

The council makes the following order in exercise of the powers conferred by section 86 of the 2007 Act.

Citation and commencement

1, (1) This Order may be cited as the District of New Forest (Reorganisation of Community Governance) (Ellingham, Harbridge & Ibsley Parish Council) Order 2015.

(2) It shall come into force on the ordinary day of election of councillors in 2015 and, for the purpose of proceedings preliminary or relating to the elections of councillors for the parish of Ellingham, Harbridge, on the day following the date on which it is made.

Interpretation

2. In this Order –

"district" means the district of New Forest

"ordinary day of election of councillors" has the meaning given by section 37 of the Representation of the People Act 1983"

Number of parish councillors for the parish of Ellingham, Harbridge & Ibsley

3. The number of parish councillors to be elected for the parish of Ellingham, Harbridge & Ibsley shall be 10.
