

CHANGES TO GODSHILL'S BOUNDARIES WITH FORDINGBRIDGE AND GODSHILL – OUTCOME OF COMMUNITY GOVERNANCE REVIEW

During 2010, New Forest District Council has considered and consulted on a request by Godshill Parish Council to amend the Parish's boundaries with Breamore and Fordingbridge. All responses from residents, the affected parish/town councils and statutory consultees were either in support of, or raised no objection to, the proposals.

The District Council has now decided to make a reorganisation order to give effect to the changes requested by Godshill Parish Council. These are shown on the maps marked "A and "B". The Council has also decided that there should be a change in the names of the affected parish/town councils, or in the size of the councils.

The Council now has to make a "reorganisation order" and make it, together with appropriate maps, available for inspection by the public. These will be posted on the District Council's website:

The order, and the changes in the parish boundaries, will come into effect on 1 April 2011.
